Anatoly Kaplan: The Enchanted Tailor

Sholem Aleichem in Soviet Graphic Art, Through October 4, 2026

Mishkan Or Museum is proud to present, from its permanent collection, the extraordinary art of Anatoly Kaplan (1901-1980), a major graphic artist of Soviet Russia largely unknown in the USA.

The Enchanted Tailor is a series of lithographs created in 1950s USSR based on Sholem Aleichem's beloved story. It stands as a rare instance of Jewish culture openly presented to Soviet audiences. Kaplan, whose own parents were murdered in the Rogachov ghetto, depicted the shtetl not as nostalgia but as testimony to a world the Holocaust had devastated, and Soviet censors sought to erase.

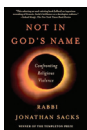

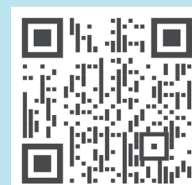

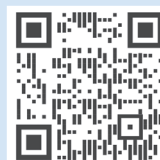
