Seating for High Holy Days services will be first-come, first-seated. Our ushers and staff will be on hand to welcome you, answer questions, and guide you to available seats as worship spaces fill.

What to Know	Details
Membership Renewal	Tickets and security badges will be available for pick-up after membership renewal is confirmed. Renewing your membership simply confirms your intention to continue your connection with and support of Mishkan Or for the coming year. Members may make a payment, establish a payment plan, or speak with a staff member regarding financial arrangements. A payment is not required to confirm your renewal. Questions? High Holy Day Central Opens Friday, July 31	High Holy Days packets, including tickets and security badges, may be picked up at Congregation Mishkan Or beginning July 31
Hours Mon-Thur 9 – 5 pm Friday 9-3 pm & 5-7 pm	Guest tickets/badges can be purchased on/after July 31
Will Call	Will Call will be available at Beachwood only, immediately before services. If you plan to begin or spend all of your High Holy Days at MPAC, please pick up your packet in advance.
If pickup is impossible	Contact hhd@mishkanor.org or 216-455-6054 so we can assist before the holidays.
Seating	Seating is first-come, first-seated. Please avoid saving large blocks of seats. Once a room reaches safe capacity, worshippers may be guided to another service space.
Livestream	All services from Beachwood and MPAC will be livestreamed through the Mishkan Or website. More details will be shared closer to the holidays.

Ticket	Please bring your printed ticket.
Security Badge	Please wear your badge using the provided clip or lanyard.
Prayer Books	Please bring Mishkan HaNefesh Gold for Rosh Hashanah and Silver for Yom Kippur if you have them.
Need Books?	Loaner prayer books will be available at both locations.

Need to Know	Details
Forgot your ticket or badge at Beachwood?	Go to the clearly marked Will Call table outside the building before proceeding to services.
Forgot your ticket or badge at MPAC?	Please see a Mishkan Or staff member on-site for assistance. Advance packet pickup is strongly encouraged for those starting at MPAC.
Need accessibility assistance?	Please reach out in advance whenever possible. On-site, speak with a staff member or usher.
Rosh Hashanah Oneg	Oneg will be provided following Rosh Hashanah services. Timing and locations will be shared leading up to the holidays.
Yom Kippur Food & Hospitality	In keeping with Yom Kippur as a day of fasting, food will not be served. Water will be available in the hospitality suite for those who need it. If a medical need arises and food is required, please find a Mishkan Or staff member so we can assist discreetly.
Hospitality Suite	Available on both Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur for anyone who may need a quiet place, medical privacy, water, or staff assistance.
Tashlich	No reservation is required. Everyone is warmly invited. Watch for final location, parking, weather, and gathering details.
Kever Dorot	No reservation is required. Everyone is warmly invited. Watch for cemetery arrival, parking, accessibility, and weather details.

A note about capacity

To keep services safe, comfortable, and welcoming, our staff and ushers will monitor room capacity throughout the holidays. If a room reaches safe capacity, we will help direct you to another available worship space or livestream option.
